## World Directory of Medical Schools Subscription Data Dictionary

The World Directory Subscription Service provides access to data from the World Directory of Medical Schools in either CSV or XML format. This data dictionary presents descriptions of all data fields available through subscription. The names and descriptions of each data field in the CSV data files are listed below by file name. The same information is then presented in alphabetical order by data field name beginning on Page 5 of this document.

**School.csv**: This main table contains one row for each school listed in the *World Directory* and each parent school (university) with which medical schools may be affiliated.
